## **INSTRUCTIONS TO SEND ONE POSTER OR ONE PAPER AFTER ACCEPTATION**

### **How to send**

All posters and papers sent to the Conference must comply with the instructions specified in the **Model File**, which is available at the Conference website ([www.congresoarteilustracion.org](http://www.congresoarteilustracion.org)).

Each participant can send one contribution, regardless of their format (poster or paper). The selection of contributions will be done following a peer review process.

Should your work be chosen, it will be published in the Abstracts Proceedings of the 2nd International Conference of Art, Illustration and Visual Culture in Infant and Primary Education.

In order to take part in the conference you must send a Word file (DOC, not DOCX and we will not accept PDF format), in accordance with the following specifications:

- The doc. file must contain the abstract number assigned by EasyChair and two initials of the name of the first author. Example - Joaquim Vasconcelos: 125\_JV.doc
- The text may be written in any of the two official languages to be used in the conference: Spanish or English.
- The text must include:
  - Title of the paper or poster, up to 5 key words and a summary that must be translated into English (500 words)
  - Introduction, development, conclusions and bibliographical references .
- The document must be no longer than 5 pages in A4 format and can contain a maximum of 20,000 characters (including spaces). It must be formatted according to the specifications stated in the Model File, which is available at the Conference website.
- The file must not exceed 5,120 KB (5MB) in weight.

**The full Text of your contribution will be published in the conference proceedings website (ISBN) only if one of the authors attend to the conference.**
